PART 1 GENERAL AND COMMERCIAL SPECIFICATIONS

1 Title of Procurement

Offshore Pipeline External Survey and Jacket Inspection 3-year Campaign

2 Objectives of Procurement

The objective of this Terms of Reference is to procure a complete subsea external inspection and cathodic protection inspection services of jacket structures shown in PART 3 TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS, Table 4-1 and offshore natural gas pipelines, shown in PART 3 TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS Table 4-2 which are located in the Gulf of Thailand.

A 500-m zone subsea pipeline portion and riser portion of the pipelines are included where the pipeline originates from a platform. Further details of the jackets and the pipelines information are provided in Appendix 1 Jacket and Tripod Information and Appendix 2 Pipelines Information, respectively. Field layout showing pipeline routes is also presented in Appendix 3 Field Layout of Pipelines.

The objectives shall be achieved by employing the methodology described in PART 3 TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS, Section 3 Inspection Methodology to cover the total scope described in Section 4 Scope of Work.

3 Introduction to BIDDERS

3.1 Definitions

For definitions of terms used in the bid documents, please refer to Appendix 8 PTT Draft Contract Specimen, ARTICLE 1 and PART 3 TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS, Section 1 Definitions.


3.2 Eligible Bidders

The Invitation to Bid is open to all bidders. The BIDDERS will be qualified by using requirements in 3.3 BIDDER Qualification Criteria and Technical Proposal evaluation.

3.3 BIDDER Qualification Criteria

Evaluation of commercial bid will be performed for qualified bidder who pass the following 2 qualification criteria:

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3.3.1 General Qualification Criteria

Bidder shall obtain the qualifications as follows:

- A) Bidder shall not be the person with the previous record of the Contract being terminated by PTT as the result from committing the corrupted act.
- B) Bidder shall not be a litigant in any arbitration dispute with PTT, whether the Bidder is appeared in PTT Approved Vendor List (PTT AVL) or not, unless otherwise the dispute has been resolved. Bidder in clause A) and B) shall include their shareholders and directors.
- C) Bidder shall not be a person with a previous record of abandoning any work undertaken as declared by PTT and the Comptroller General's Department.
- D) On the day of the auction, bidder shall not have any joint interest with other bidders or is not a person who will cause obstruction for a fair auction.
- E) A bidder submitting false qualification information shall be subject to disqualification of its bid or cancellation of the Contract and forfeiture of performance security. In addition, BIDDERS that fail to submit documentation demonstrating that they meet the minimum requirements specified will be disqualified.


3.3.2 Qualification Criteria on ESG: Environment, Social, Governance

- A) A BIDDER shall comply with the following conditions:

Conduct a self-assessment in accordance with the attached Sustainability Performance Assessment Form (external form no. F-จก.จปญ.-99-0074), which is attached within this instruction-to-bid package by PTT General Procurement Division and deemed as part of the bidding documents by PTT. BIDDER is requested to attach assessment results in Corporate Documents.

If it is found that the Self-assessment result in accordance with the Clause a) is less than a score of 2.5 or the performance of the BIDDER does not conform to the ESG Interception Criteria, the BIDDER shall present an ESG Corrective Action Plan (external form no. F-จก.จปญ.-99-0075) for the consideration of PTT (within a prescribed period).

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In the event the Procurement Committee concludes that the **BIDDER** provided insufficient documents or prescribed an impact management plan as per Clause b) which is found to be significantly insufficient, **PTT** reserves the right not to consider selecting such **BIDDER**.

- B) **PTT** reserves the right to inspect the sustainability performance as appropriate and if **PTT** finds that the selected supplier does not have the qualifications in accordance with the ESG Interception Criteria or does not perform in accordance with **PTT** Supplier Sustainable Code of Conduct (SSCoC) or fails to proceed the work as per the ESG Corrective Action Plan or finds that the level or condition of performance is less than that provided by law which may result in a loss, **PTT** reserves the right to suspend the work until it has been remedied or to terminate the Contract. In the event of delay due to such cessation of work leads to the **CONTRACTOR** not being able to deliver the work within the period prescribed by **PTT**, the **CONTRACTOR** shall pay a penalty as specified in the general conditions. Furthermore, **PTT** reserves the right to prohibit such supplier from participating in the future bidding.

3.3.3 Qualification Criteria on Specific Project Requirements


In the absence of pre-qualification, **PTT** will determine to its satisfaction by evaluation of **BIDDER's** experience and post-qualification information that **BIDDER's** are qualified to satisfactorily perform the Contract. The determination will take into account the **BIDDER's** financial, inspection and survey capabilities. It will be based upon an examination of the documentary evidence of the **BIDDER's** qualifications submitted by the **BIDDER**, pursuant to Section 5.2, as well as such other information as **PTT** deems necessary and appropriate.

3.3.3.1 Financial Capability

BIDDER who is qualified shall possess the following financial qualifications and shall include evidence in the Corporate Document Envelop:

- Minimum Company Registered Capital of U.S. \$0.35 million dollars (for overseas **BIDDER**) or 10 million Thai Baht (for Thai **BIDDER**). (ทุนจดทะเบียนที่ชำระมูลค่าหุ้นแล้ว)

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This qualification information shall be submitted in accordance with Appendix 7 Bidding Forms, Form 2, Table A7 - 5 and Table A7 - 6 in Corporate Document envelop. Only information in Table A7 - 5 will be used to evaluate the BIDDER's prior to entering e-auction, whereas Table A7 - 6 will be used as supplementary information and will not affect evaluation undertaken at Table A7 - 5.

3.3.3.2 Capability to Survey Pipelines

Potential BIDDER shall be able to demonstrate that the BIDDER have acquired the experience as main CONTRACTOR in successfully completing or substantially completing at least 5 projects of external survey and CP inspection, using survey vessel and ROV, of subsea natural gas or oil pipelines with diameter of not less than 18", and with length of pipeline section not less than 50 km during the last 10 years.

Substantially completed projects mean those projects which are at least 80% completed as on the date of bid submission (i.e. gross value of work done up to the last date of submission is 80% or more of the original Contract price) and continuing satisfactorily.

3.3.3.3 Capability to Survey Platforms

Potential BIDDER shall be able to demonstrate that the BIDDER have acquired the experience as main CONTRACTOR in successfully completing at least 5 projects reference in each of the following inspection task, using survey vessel and ROV of offshore platforms with water depth not less than 60 m, during the last 10 years:

- Subsea visual inspection;
- CP inspection; and
- FMD inspection.

3.4 Cost of Bidding

The BIDDER shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of its bid, and PTT will in no case be responsible or liable for those costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the bidding process.
